



- Idaho: Removed studentIDs from the list of accepted IDs
- Wyoming: Added concealed carry permits to the list of accepted IDs for in-person voting



# Changes in Voting Modes








# Early In-Person Voting







- New Jersey, South Carolina and Wyoming: Allowed absentee/mail processing to begin sooner (2022)
- Arkansas: Allows absentee
   voting for those with a
   religious holiday or
   observance on Election Day
- Arkansas and South Dakota:
   Prohibits the use of pre-filled absentee ballot applications



Finetuning Absentee/Mail Voting

- Michigan: Required drop boxes (2022)
- Arkansas, Missouri (2022)and South Dakota:Prohibited drop boxes
- UT: 24-hour surveillance (2022)



Ballot Drop Boxes







- 45 states have some kind of ballot tracking system
- Arizona and New York:
   Passed legislation to
   establish ballot tracking
   systems (2022)


- 24 states allow voters to cure their ballots
- Louisiana: Created a ballot cure process (2022)





# States Prohibiting Private Funds in Elections











- Colorado, Maine, New
   Hampshire and Oregon:
   Prohibited intimidation and set
   criminal penalties (2022)
- Oklahoma: Created criminal penalties for threats and impersonation
- Maine: Required de-escalation training and the SOS to record reports of threats (2022)


- Proof of citizenship at registration
- 2. Voter registration list maintenance to identify potential noncitizens
- 3. Constitutional bans on noncitizens voting
