# **HAVA Election Security Funds**





- Over \$4 billion in federal funds has been awarded since 2003
- Formula grants to support:
  - upgrading voting systems,
  - statewide voter registration databases,
  - providing provisional voting options, and
  - implementing other improvements to the administration of federal elections

# **HAVA Election Security Funds**



- Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023:
   \$75 million in Election Security grant funds.
- Total Election Security grant funds to date:
  - \$380 million (2018)
  - \$425 million (2020)
  - \$75 million (2022)
  - \$75 million (2023)
  - \$955 million Total



### **HAVA CARES Grants**






- Congress provided CARES ACT funds to "prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus for the 2020 federal election cycle."
- As of December 31, 2020, states expended 84% of the roughly \$400 million provided by Congress
  - As of March 2023,
     \$63,725,245 of CARES federal funds have been returned

#### **HAVA College Poll Worker Grant Program**







- The College Program grants are intended to:
  - Encourage student participation as poll workers or assistants
  - Foster student interest in the elections process,
  - encourage state and local governments to use students as poll workers
  - Relieve poll worker shortages
- In our FY23 budget, we received \$1 million to fund this grant program.
