FUNDED BY SAMHSA

The 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline (988 Lifeline) is funded by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) and administered by Vibrant Emotional Health. The Lifeline launched in 2005.

24/7

The 988 Lifeline provides free and confidential emotional support to people in suicidal crisis or emotional distress 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, across the United States.



What do the stats tell us about suicide?

Current State




America is experiencing a mental health crisis.

- 48,183 Americans died by suicide in 2021.
- Making it the 11th leading cause of death in the U.S.
- 90% of those who died by suicide had a diagnosable mental health condition at the time of their death.
- Second leading cause of death for individuals aged 10 - 24; Fifth for ages 35-54
- 22% of Americans experienced a mental illness in 2021
- Depression is a leading cause of disability world wide



Suicide Rates

Suicide rates increased 37% between 2000-2018 and decreased 5% between 2018-2020. However, rates nearly returned to their peak in 2021.





Disparities in Suicide



Some groups have disproportionately high rates of suicide/attempts.

The suicide rate among females increased 4% in 2021(CDC, 2023)


The suicide rates for males was three to four and a half times the rate for females during the 2001-2021 period (CDC, 2023).

The suicide death rate amongst black youth has been found to be increasing faster than other racial/ethnic group. (CBCF, 2019)

IGBTQ youth are four times more likely to make a suicide attempt than their peers (Trevor Project, 2021)



Epidemic of Loneliness



Surgeon General Advisory (2023)

- Expensive (6.7 Billion annually in medicaid spending)
- Highest rates of social isolation
- Hypertension Risk
- Chronic lone liness and social isolation can increase the risk of developing dementia by approximately 50% in older adults.

CDC (2021)

- Social isolation significantly increased a person's risk of premature death from all causes
- Poor social relationships (characterized by social isolation or lone liness) was associated with a 29% increased risk of heart disease and a 32% increased risk of stroke.
- Lone liness was associated with higher rates of depression, anxiety, and suicide.
- Lone liness among heart patients sig increased the risk of death

Structure

The number of relationships, variety of relationships (e.g., co-worker, friend, family, neighbor), and the frequency of interactions with others.

Function

The degree to which others can be relied upon for various needs.

Quality

The degree to which relationships and interactions with others are positive, helpful, or satisfying (vs. negative, unhelpful, or unsatisfying).



The 988 Lifeline answered **159,040 more** contacts (calls, chats and texts) and significantly improved how quickly contacts were answered.

The average speed to answer across all contacts decreased from 140 seconds to **35 seconds**.

In May 2023 vs. May 2022, calls answered increased by 45%, chats answered increased by 52%, and texts answered increased by 938%.
