

## 7. LEGISLATIVE DOCUMENTS

### Access to Printed Legislative Documents

**Printing.** Perhaps the most visible product of state legislatures is paper. Calendars, journals, bills, reports, digests, session laws, schedules and directories are just a few of the documents generated by the process and the institution. Access to printed versions of these documents is wide; almost every chamber reported that printed documents are made available to legislators, legislative staff, the governor’s office, state agencies, local governments, academic institutions, lobbyists, the media and the general public. Printing, therefore, is often a major responsibility of legislative clerks.

The clerk’s office often is involved in the composition and layout of many legislative documents. Tables 97-7.1 and 97-7.2 illustrate the extent of this involvement. However, once the documents are ready for publication, the actual printing may be turned over to a legislative print shop, the state printer or a private contractor. Tables 97-7.3 through 97-7.6 show by whom various documents are printed. For example, the clerk will print bills in-house, while the journal is produced by a private contractor.

Time is a valuable commodity for legislatures. As a result, many legislative functions—including printing—are placed on a “fast track.” Transactions taken one day often must be ready for further action by the next. Thus, many documents must be printed overnight or sooner; table 97-7.7 indicates which ones.

Since the legislative process is fast paced, changes can occur quickly and frequently. Although chambers need sufficient documents to distribute to members and others, they also aim to control costs and waste. As a result, many legislatures print fewer copies today than in previous years. Tables 97-7.8 and 97-7.9 show the minimum number of copies of various documents printed by each legislative body.

Some chambers have shifted to “on-demand printing.” That is, they do not keep extra copies in stock; a document is printed only when—and in the number—requested. Forty-three chambers (shown below) indicated that they use on-demand printing. In addition, the Connecticut Legislature may switch to on-demand printing if the results of a recent pilot project prove successful.

Certain documents are more likely to be printed on demand. Table 97-7.10 illustrates the types of documents that typically are printed on demand.

The legislative bodies that use on-demand printing reported several benefits. It increases efficiency in the bill distribution process, saves staff time associated with collating and handling documents, reduces paper and printing costs, reduces in storage space requirements and reduces waste. In fact, one chamber estimated that its on-demand printing system saves approximately \$600,000 per year.

***Charges for Printed Documents.*** To cover increased printing costs, many state legislatures charge non-legislative groups and individuals for legislative documents. Table 97-7.11 indicates which groups are charged for multiple copies of printed legislative documents. Tables 97-7.13 and 97-7.14 provide detailed information about the charges and subscription rates set by legislative assemblies.
