WHAT IS THE BILL INFORMATION SERVICE?

The BIS provides access to the full text of legislation in the 50 states, the District of Columbia and the U.S. Congress for the current session as well as past sessions.

You can search for legislation by bill number, committee, sponsor, state and term, phrase or topic.

As a NCSL member, you are granted exclusive access to this service along with all state legislators and legislative staff.

HOW DO I ACCESS IT?

Login to NCSL's website at www.ncsl.org using the login link in the top right corner.

Next, mouse over to the Research tab located in the grey bar. Under the Tools heading, select Bill Tracking. From here, you can access NCSL's 50-State Bill Tracking Databases, along with the BIS.

Once you are connected to the BIS, start searching!

NCSL provides access to research tools for members to search state legislation and learn more about a wide variety of policy topics.

NCSL staff curate and maintain 50-state information in NCSL's searchable bill tracking databases that cover a variety of policy issues. More than 50 current and archived databases are available to members and the public on NCSL's webpage.

NCSL members can also search all state and federal legislation by using NCSL's Bill Information Service, a powerful research tool hosted by LexisNexis State Net that provides access to up-to-date legislation in all 50 states, Washington, D.C. and the territories.
