Jointly Proposed Litigation Timeline IF the District Court Rejects the Remedial Map

Date	Action
3 days after the Court's order	Plaintiffs' and amici's proposed plans and supporting arguments (including mapmaking criteria), data, and reports are due
8 days after the Court's order	Parties' oppositions to proposed plans and supporting data and reports are due
14 days after the Court's order	Special master and expert cartographer's recommendation will be due
17 days after the Court's order	Objections to the special master and expert cartographer's recommendation will be due
