What is SafeUT

§ SafeUT is a Crisis Chat Line and a School Safety Tip Line developed for Utah students, parents, and educators

§ SafeUT began enrolling schools in January 2016

§ 2019 continued Legislative support of SafeUT: HB373 – Student Support Amendments (Chief Sponsor: Rep. Steve Eliason)


Why SafeUT?

- § Suicide is the leading cause of death for Utahns aged 10-24
- § According to the 2017 Youth Risk Behavior Survey, during the past 12 months before the survey Utah high school students reported the following: 33.0% felt sad or hopeless, 21.6% seriously considered attempting suicide, 17.1% made a suicide plan, 9.6% attempted suicide one or more times and 4.0% of these students suffered an injury, poisoning, or an overdose that had to be treated by a doctor or nurse.



How Does It Work?

Features of SafeUT

- Submit a Tip Concerns about school safety (weapons, bullying, self-harm, drugs etc.) are immediately sent to both SafeUT staff and the school to evaluate
- Start a Chat Therapeutic dialogue through texting with a SafeUT Licensed Crisis Worker
- Start a Call Therapeutic dialogue through a phone conversation with a SafeUT Licensed Crisis Worker










How to Start a Chat









Success Stories

qA student used SafeUT to call the Crisis Line as he was actively thinking about walking into traffic. SafeUT staff were able to contact local Police and the school who worked together to locate the student and ensure his safety.

qA concerned friend sent a Tip and school officials were able to stop a fight where a student was being bullied after his parent died by suicide.

qA student took a cocktail of medications as a suicide attempt before school. After being reminded of SafeUT at an assembly that school morning, he sent in a chat to ask for help.



Success Stories

- q Multiple tips came in about a potential school threat. SafeUT, working in collaboration with local authorities and the school, verified the tips. Police were sent to the student's home where they found homemade pipe bombs in various stages of completion.
- q A mother of a student who has dealt with mental health issues most of his life stated "I thought him and I were in a good place, I felt he could talk to me about his feelings and he seemed to be doing so much better. Without me knowing, he went on Instagram and posted three back to back messages stating he was going to kill himself. His friends saw the posts and immediately sent tips into SafeUT. They contacted the police and I got a phone call from the officer who was at my front door. My son and the officer talked and we were able to get him immediate help. I am amazed at the efficiency of SafeUT, from the initial posts to the officer knocking on my door was less than 10 minutes".
